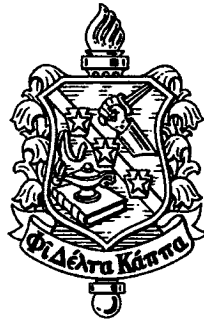

PDK Scholarship Information

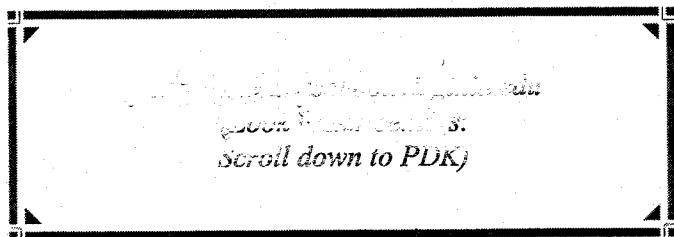
The University of Virginia chapter is pleased to announce the awarding of \$500.00 scholarships to three outstanding area high school graduates planning a career in teaching. Emily Likins, from Orange County High School, will attend James Madison University, Nadia Manifold, from Fluvanna County High School, will attend Mary Baldwin College, and Jennifer Arrington, from William Monroe high School, will attend the University of Virginia. Additionally, Jennifer was the esteemed recipient of a \$1,000 scholarship from Phi Delta Kappa International (our chapter's first recipient of this award). Thirteen area public high schools are within our district and scholarship applications are sent to the respective guidance departments in the fall. These applications are due back to the chapter January 31st and three are selected for the chapter awards with one also being forwarded to International for competition at the highest level. It is important to note that our chapter's level of financial support for these area scholarships dramatically increased this year as we proudly honor our commitment to public education by encouraging these prospective new teachers in their chosen career.
